AGREED ORDER
OF SUSPENSION

COMES NOW the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction, under the authority granted by the laws of the state of Washington, having reviewed the file of the above-referenced case, and having considered the entire evidence contained therein, does hereby stipulate by and between the Office of Professional Practices (OPP), Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI), and Devon Morehead, that the Washington Education Certificate, No. 403485F, of Devon Morehead, shall be suspended, based on the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth below:

FINDING OF FACTS

1. Devon Morehead was issued a Washington Education Certificate, No. 403485F, on October 25, 2002. That certificate currently remains valid.
 2. Devon Morehead was employed by the Castle Rock School District.

3. On June 18, 2009, the Office of Professional Practices, within OSPI, received a complaint letter from the superintendent of the Castle Rock School District alleging a lack of good moral character or personal fitness, or a violation of the Code of Professional Conduct, Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 181-87, by Devon Morehead.

4. During the 2008-2009 school year, Devon Morehead used Castle Rock School District computer equipment to access and attempt to access sexually explicit material.

5. Castle Rock School District Procedure No. 2022P titled, Electronic Information System (K-20 Network), states that “(1) All use of the system must be in support of education and research and consistent with the mission of the district. (7) use of the system to access, store, or distribute obscene or pornographic material is prohibited.”

6. On February 19, 2009, Susan Barker, Castle Rock School District Superintendent, placed Devon Morehead on administrative leave and issued a Notice of Nonrenewal and Suspension with Pay.

7. On September 22, 2009, Devon Morehead participated in an interview with an OPP investigator. On October 23, 2009, OPP received Devon Morehead’s signed statement.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. OSPI has jurisdiction over Devon Morehead and over the subject matter of this action.

2. OSPI has shown by clear and convincing evidence that Washington Education Certificate, No. 403485F, of Devon Morehead, should be suspended as provided for in WAC 181-86-070.

3. Devon Morehead has violated WAC 181-87-060, RCW 28A.410.090, WAC 181-86-013, and/or WAC 181-86-014.

THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered and agreed that the Washington Education Certificate, No. 403485F, of Devon Morehead, be suspended for four (4) months from the date of entry of this Order.


Reinstatement shall require submission of a new application, including Character and Fitness Supplement, provided by OPP and having Devon Morehead's fingerprints be checked by both the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and the Washington State Patrol (WSP). Reinstatement shall be also contingent upon Devon Morehead's fingerprint background check returning with no criminal convictions that are listed in WAC 181-86-013, RCW 28A.410.090, and/or any felony convictions


