

## “After-Exit” Running Start Proviso Assurances 2024 Summer

Please review the assurances below before registering students meeting/exceeding Annual Average Full-Time Equivalent (AAFTE) limits or graduating with the Class of 2024 for summer quarter Running Start or reporting enrollment for these students.

By submitting these assurances with an “After-Exit” summer Running Start enrollment report, the college listed below is requesting Running Start tuition payment for courses taken by students eligible for the summer quarter in accordance with the “After-Exit” Running Start proviso included in [Substitute Senate Bill 5187 \(2023\)\(522\)\(2\)\(i\)](#). Therefore, the undersigned party attests that:

- All students included on the report met one of the following requirements and therefore were eligible to enroll in the summer quarter and access the “After-Exit” Running Start proviso funds.
  - They were graduating with the Class of 2024, as verified by a high school transcript or documentation signed by a school counselor or school administrator, and within 15 college credits of an associate degree.
  - They are a non-graduating 11th or 12th grade student who met the maximum Running Start 1.40 AAFTE enrollment limit in the 2023–2024 school year.
  - They are a non-graduating 5th year (or beyond) senior who met the maximum Running Start enrollment limit over the course of multiple 12th grade years.
- All students included on the report participated in the summer term and had not withdrawn by the summer quarter drop date.
- For Class of 2024 graduates, the college is requesting payment for only those credits that fulfilled associate degree requirements, not to exceed a maximum of 15 college credits per eligible student.
- For non-graduating 11th or 12th grade students, the college is requesting payment for a maximum of 10 college credits per eligible student.
- The college waived applicable fees for all participating students eligible for free or reduced-price lunch (FRPL) pursuant to college policy and in accordance with [Revised Code of Washington 28A.600.310](#).
- The college has notified each high school of the students’ summer quarter enrollment.
- The college understands that payment for students/credits reported by August 15, 2024 will be made through the August apportionment. No late submissions will be accepted or processed.
