

Food, Body, and Mind Awards

Operated through Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) Child Nutrition Services, this awards program seeks to recognize schools, child care institutions, and non-profit organizations who make exceptional efforts to support child nutrition.



Overview

These awards are available to sponsors of the National School Lunch and Breakfast Programs (NSLP & SBP), the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP), or the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) and the schools, institutions, and meal sites under their jurisdiction. Sponsoring organizations must be in good standing with OSPI Child Nutrition Services and have no outstanding corrective action on an Administrative Review to receive an award.

Applications are accepted and evaluated on an ongoing basis. Applicants can apply for awards in one or more award category.

Award Details

The award period is three years. Awardees will receive a certificate of recognition signed by the director of Child Nutrition Services and be recognized statewide on the OSPI website and through other statewide highlights.
