Per Engrossed Substitute Senate Bill (ESSB) 5693 (4)(gg), OSPI is charged with contracting with a community-based youth development nonprofit organization for a pilot program to provide behavioral health support for youth.

Accordingly, Section A.5. Bidder Qualifications is amended as follows:

### **A.5. BIDDER QUALIFICATIONS**

#### **Minimum Qualifications:**

- Licensed to do business in the State of Washington. If not licensed, provide a written intent to become licensed in Washington within thirty (30) calendar days of being selected as the Apparent Successful Bidder.
- Provider must have a statewide reach, including small, rural communities.
- Knowledge of trauma-informed, culturally responsive youth supports.
- Ability to develop, deliver in person and/or virtual professional development.
- Experience evaluating large-scale professional development efforts.
- Nonprofit organization, as required by ESSB 5693
- Community-based youth development organization, as required by ESSB 5693

Consultants who do not meet these minimum qualifications will be rejected as non-responsive and will not receive further consideration. Any proposal that is rejected as non-responsive will not be evaluated or scored.

#### **Desirable Qualifications:**

- History of working in communities with at-risk, marginalized youth from various income standards.
