History

■ K-3 class size compliance requirements for high poverty and non-high poverty 2015-17 biennial appropriations act in section 502 on page 204

"(B) For grades kindergarten through three, the superintendent shall allocate funding for class size reductions to the extent of, and in proportion to, the **school district's** demonstrated actual weighted average class size for grades kindergarten through three down to the weighted average class size specified in subsections 2(c)(i) (A) of this section. At a minimum, the superintendent must allocate funding sufficient to fund a weighted average class size not to exceed 25.23 full-time equivalent students per teacher in these grades."

- WAC sections 392-140-915 through 392-140-945
- Effective 2015-16 and 2016-17 school years
- 2017-18 budgets have the same class size of 17 for both high poverty and non-high poverty and neither have K-3 compliance requirements.



When are the compliance calculations performed?

- S-275 data will be pulled three times a school year; January, March & June Final calculation for 2016-17 will be performed June 20, 2017.

Which staff are included?

■ Teachers coded to program 01-Basic Education grade groupings K, 1, 2, and 3:

Duty root 31–Elementary Homeroom Teacher

Duty root 33–Other Teacher

Duty root 34–Elementary Specialist Teacher

Duty root 52–Substitute Teacher

Duty root 63—Contractor Teacher

- Specialists such as P.E. and music teachers should be coded to duty root 34 not duty root 31.
- Librarians, counselors or other ESA staff are not included.
- ALE teachers as well as students are not included.
- A portion of program 21 teachers will be included using your district's 3121 revenue.



Supplemental teacher reporting tool

Districts are to utilize the tool as a means of reporting supplemental teachers per WAC-140-934.

This form bridges the gap for teachers starting/changing assignments after the October 1st date and is available on SAFS website http://www.k12.wa.us/SAFS/default.asp.

- 1. Enter grade level impacted (K, 1, 2, or 3)
- 2. Enter "X" in either "New" or "Reassigned" box
- 3. Enter duty root, first and last name of teacher
- 4. Enter positive or negative FTE value compared to the baseline S-275 reporting (the sum of a new teacher's FTE will be less than 1)
- 5. Sum all the FTE changes by grade level in Net Impact section

Used to calculate the general apportionment portion of the FTE.

Can be found on the 1220 Report as well as the Budget page on the SAFS website.

Multiply Special Ed Teacher with the 3121 % and that total (F) is added to the other teachers.

Weighted factors calculation

- Demonstrated Class Size (I)
 For each grade level, divide student FTE (B)
 by total teachers (H).
- Weighted Average Factor (J)
 For each grade level multiply student FTE
 (B) by demonstrated class size (I).
- State Budget Weighted Average Factor (K)

For each grade level multiply student FTE (B) by state budget class size.

- Weighted Average Class Size
 Weighted average factor total of column (J) divided by total student FTEs in column (B)
- State Budget Weighted Average Class Size
 - State budget weighted average factor total of column (K) divided by total student FTEs in column (B).
- Class Size used in Apportionment
 Greater of the two above calculations and not to exceed 25.23.
