- Pay per-teacher registration fees: \$1,500 per NEW teacher; \$300 per RETURNING teacher.
- Ensure NEW teacher participation in the required Summer Institute.
- Support all Bridge to College teachers to participate in professional development meetings during the school year including curriculum workshops and Community of Practice meetings (up to the equivalent of 25 clock hours).
- Support any travel, time, substitute, or supply costs incurred during the school year for new and returning teachers.
- Use specified Bridge to College course name and code in CEDARS and school catalogue.

- Respond to communications and requests from OSPI and SBCTC in a timely manner including updating registration with current teacher information.
- Collaborate with OSPI, State Board for Community and Technical Colleges (SBCTC), and project evaluators to support Bridge to College course evaluation and refinement efforts, including responding to requests for student data and providing access to classrooms and teachers for observations and gathering feedback related to course implementation.
