INSTRUCTIONS

This table lists minimum ACT or SAT test scores and overall high school GPAs required for a student to be nominated for an Honors Award. To use the table:

- 1. Locate the student's composite ACT or SAT score.
- 2. Note the Minimum GPA value associated with that score.
- 3. If the GPA is equal to or greater than this value, the student can be <u>nominated</u> for an Honors Award.

A tool for assistance in determining eligibility is available on the Washington State Honors Award EDS Nomination Application. Enter the students GPA and highest test score from the same column, hit enter and the status box will read "No HA" if the student does not meet the eligibility criteria or "HA Recipient" if they do.

For example, a student with an Math SAT of 745 and an Evidence-Based Reading and Writing of 745 would require a minimum GPA of 2.73 to be eligible. Similarly, an overall GPA of 3.31 is required to nominate a student with an ACT score of 30. *Only test scores taken after September 1, 2016, and prior to January 31, 2020, should be considered in determining eligibility.*
