
Best Interest Determination Student-Centered Factors



Student Focused Determinations

Best interest decisions should be student focused and consider all the above factors. When making decisions regarding change of schools for a student, consider:

- The academic, social, and emotional impact that transferring to a new school may have on the student.
- If the student has special education needs, the impact that changing schools may have on their progress and access to services. If a school change is indicated, ensure that evaluations and/or services are not interrupted.
- Which programs at the two schools are comparable and appropriate for the child.
- The commute to school in terms of the distance, mode of transportation, and travel time, and whether it is age appropriate and manageable for the student.
- Information about the immediate and long-term educational plans for the student, and information about the student's permanency plan as it relates to school stability.
