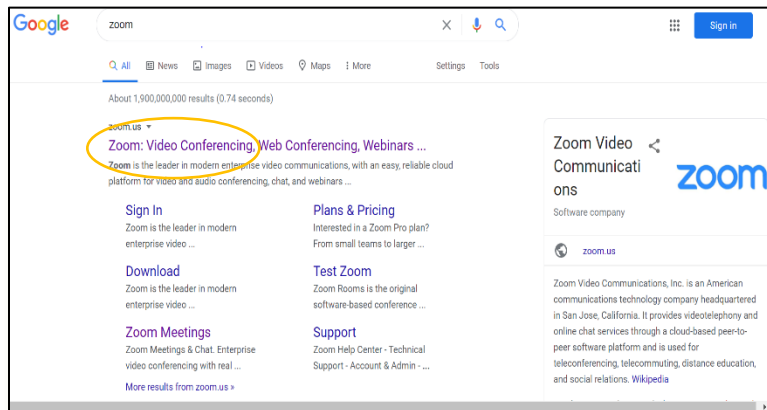


Step-by-Step Access to Zoom

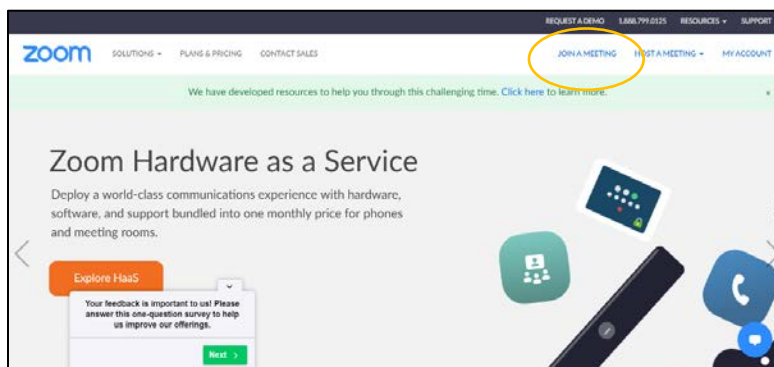
1. Use the latest version of Chrome or Firefox.
2. Go to your Internet browser and type: Zoom.




3. Select the first option.



4. In the upper right corner, select: JOIN A MEETING.




5. Type the Meeting ID from the invitation email into the field.




