If LEA wants to offer during the 2023–24 school year for CTE enhanced funding, course application must be completed by LEA prior to reporting the course enrollment for CTE enhanced funding. Courses are eligible for CTE enhanced funding from the date of course approval. If a course was claimed for CTE enhanced funding and was not approved in the prior year, adjustments to the enrollment for funding purposes must be completed by late November.
