WIDA has released the WIDA Roll-out Plan. They have released NEW Self-Paced and Facilitated workshops. **WIDA Screening Updates** Transitional Kindergarten Screening -Provisionally qualified based on Home Language Survey, Screened starting May 1st Out of State Transfers - WIDA ACCESS scores accepted from other states for qualification (within 12 months) or proof of proficiency (from any time) Kindergarten Screening - Only speaking & listening domains prior to Jan. 1st **Early Literacy Screening Guidance** • ALL K-2 multilingual learners must be screened except in their first 4 months in U.S. schools Students may be screened in languages other than English • Focus on progress over time rather than grade-level norms Considerations for screening based on
