# PURPOSE/BACKGROUND

This bulletin provides an update to the CTE Program Approval Process typically due to be completed in January for CTE courses to be approved and eligible for enhanced funding for the 2024–25 school year. In response to feedback from Local Education Agencies (LEAs), with acknowledgement of our state administrative requirements, and in alignment with our agency expectation of continuous improvement, we will not launch the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) EDS Based CTE Application Program Approval system.

In October 2023, in alignment with <u>Bulletin 064-23</u>, CTE Course Verification reports were issued to support districts, Skills Centers, and State-Tribal Education Compact Schools to evaluate course eligibility for CTE enhanced funding and to support LEAs documentation of state CTE courses. These verification reports were a comprehensive review of CTE courses eligible for CTE enhanced funding and will serve as Program Approval for existing CTE courses to be offered in the 2024–25 school year.

### New CTE Courses for 2024–25 School Year

New CTE courses for the 2024–25 school year or courses that do not have current approval require submission in the EDS based CTE Application Course Approval System. New courses for the 2024–25 school year should be submitted by April 15, 2024, for timely review and approval.

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#### **Local Documentation**

To further support local documentation efforts, the attached CTE Program Approval Local Documentation Checklist is provided to enhance district understanding of required documentation to keep on file to reflect approved CTE courses. Districts should maintain signature pages for any courses that are approved through the CTE Application Course Approval system, per typical documentation requirements. LEAs can also access the Program Approval system for previously submitted program signature pages and previously submitted approval documents, if needed.
