ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Dual Credit Programs: a student enrolls in a class that has the potential to earn both high school and college credit. Running Start (RS) is intended to provide students a program option consisting of attendance at certain higher education institutions and the simultaneous earning of high school and college/university credit. College in the high school (CHS) courses are college-level courses taught by high school teachers in the high school. Career & Technical Education (CTE) dual credit courses are taught at the middle and high school by middle/high school teachers and are approved by colleges that partner with the high school.



ELIGIBILITY

RS - students must be in grade 11 or 12 and place into college level english (ENGL 100).

CHS - students must be grade 9-12 & opt in to earn credits.
CTE - students must be enrolled in a school offering the program.
