Purpose: In alignment with SHB 1550, passed by the Washington State Legislature in 2023, the emergency rules establish the transition to kindergarten program. The rules provide for the administration of, the allocation of state funding for, and minimum standards and requirements for the transition to kindergarten program for the 2023-2024 school year.

This is a renewal of emergency rule filing as OSPI continues to conduct permanent rulemaking concerning transition to kindergarten programs. The permanent rules are anticipated to be effective by the 2024-2025 school year.
