Do You Want to Build a Snowman

Attendance Challenge



- 1) Materials are <u>here</u> and <u>here</u>.
 - a. Print each piece on a colored paper and cut them out.
 - b. The eyes and mouth are made using a Black Sharpie.
- 2) Attendance Challenge runs for 10 school days.
- 3) Classrooms or grades compete to build a snowman by earning a piece of the snowman each day.
- 4) Divide your bulletin board to accommodate however many classes/grades snowmen there will be.
- 5) **Select** the Attendance Percentage threshold to earn a piece. **For example:** *Any class with 90% or better attendance for the day earns a piece.*
- 6) A report will need to be run daily to determine who earns a snowman piece.
- 7) It is suggested to **announce daily** the classes or grades that achieved the threshold and earned a piece. This increases awareness/engagement.

8) Pieces to be earned in order:

- a. Bottom Ball
- b. Middle Ball
- c. Top Ball
- d. Eyes
- e. Nose
- f. Mouth
- g. Arm 1
- h. Arm 2
- i. Scarf
- j. Hat
- 9) The class/grade(s) with the most complete snowman wins and receives a prize. **Example:** extra recess, class party, etc.
- 10) Make sure to compare the pre-challenge attendance data to the challenge data to evaluate it's efficacy.
