

HCS March Madness Attendance Challenge

The Goal:

Increase attendance by having a friendly competition that mirrors the March Madness College Basketball Tournament.

How It Works:

1. Homerooms will be randomly selected and placed into a bracket slot.
2. Competing homerooms will be announced each week in the morning announcements.
3. ADA Percentage (scores) will be announced on Wednesdays (Half-Time) and the final will be announced on Friday afternoons.
4. The homeroom with the highest attendance percentage for the week will advance to the next level. The losing homerooms will have a second opportunity in the "B" bracket.
5. A poster of the brackets will list which teams/homerooms are competing and the scores after each week. The poster will be placed in the commons. We will continue through the brackets until we have one champion (after four weeks total).
