- · Increasing the visibility of speakers to promote language and cultural awareness
- Gaining buy-in to existing programming, ensuring widespread support and participation
- Learning the language through legends to connect students with cultural narratives
- Hosting educator nights to share culture and language, building understanding and support
- Encouraging students to become teachers to perpetuate language and culture
- Having older students take on leadership roles during cultural events
- Implementing immersion practices to enhance language acquisition
