Overview

Tacoma Online High School is a part of the Tacoma Public School District No. 10 and operates an online program in an "anywhere, anytime" asynchronous format. The school currently has 554 full-time students and 146 part-time students who take 1 or 2 online courses at TOL (TACOMA ONLINE) and the remaining courses in-person at their home building.

Tacoma Online is staffed with certified Tacoma teachers who use the Edgenuity curriculum to guide student learning. Tacoma teachers work with each student and can customize courses as they work to meet individual student needs, assess where they are academically, and help them achieve their goals. Tacoma Online offers AP, foreign language, college preparatory, Career and Technical Education courses, and many elective courses.

PACE is a program at Tacoma Online that pairs every student with an educator who serves as their PACE coach. The PACE coach is each student and family's first point of contact at Tacoma Online and a resource for their social and emotional learning. The PACE coach meets weekly with each student to monitor their progress toward their Personalized Learning Plan, making plan adjustments along the way. Additionally, each PACE coach offers daily meetings with small groups of students as another opportunity to support each student's unique learning needs. The connections made in PACE groups, both student-to-student and teacher-to-student are the key to Tacoma Online's personalized approach to learning.
