Considerations for Districts in Collecting Student Race and Ethnicity

All public schools and districts in Washington State are required to collect student race and ethnicity data and report their findings to OSPI annually. OSPI has collected these data in CEDARS since 2009, with changes along the way as required by state and federal changes. OSPI summarizes race and ethnicity data in public reports such as the State Report Card, in response to requests from the Legislature, and in annual reports to the U.S. Department of Education (Dept).

The Dept requires states to collect and report race and ethnicity information consistent with federal statistical standards. When reporting under these standards, OSPI aggregates race and ethnicity data in the following categories:

Federal Race and Ethnicity Categories:

- American Indian or Alaska Native
- Asian
- Black or African American
- Hispanic/Latino
- Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander
- Two or more races
- White

Beginning in the 2018-19 school year, OSPI has collected detailed race and ethnicity categories, guided by the work of the <u>Race and Ethnicity Student Data Task Force</u>, as authorized by 4SHB 1541 Sec 502.² The Task Force created the list of detailed categories based on research, its internal discussions, and feedback from community members through focus groups, surveys, and community forums. Collecting data in such detail provides a more informative summary of where opportunity gaps exist.

² The Race and Ethnicity Student Data Task Force was established to develop guidance for student race and ethnicity data collection in Washington State.



¹ Standards are set by the U.S. Office of Management and Budget in Directive No. 15 - Standards for Maintaining, Collecting, and Presenting Federal Data on Race and Ethnicity. These are used by the U.S. Census and other federal agencies.

When collecting race and ethnicity from students and families, OSPI encourages districts to present options in such a way that makes clear the relationship between the detailed categories and federal categories. Districts may present these visually using checkboxes, drop-down menus, concatenation, nesting, or other methods. (See **Example** below.)

While meeting reporting requirements, districts may customize or adapt the collection in a way that works for their communities. This includes –

- opportunities for 'write-in' additional responses,
- a selection to 'show all options',
- providing students and families the opportunity to update or change selections, for example annually,
- summarizing the federal category, and
- providing a letter to families explaining the collection.
