The Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) seeks experienced and passionate educators to review supplemental lessons and units submitted by OSPI grantees, contractors, and collaborators and awaiting evaluation and placement in one or more of our learning collections.

Details

- Timeframe: 7 weeks from project start date
- One-time payment: \$1000 paid at conclusion of the work
- Anticipated time commitment: 20–25 hours (reviews must be conducted outside district contracted work hours)

Scope of Work

- Attend a 3-hour online training meeting
- During a 7-week review window, use provided criteria to review assigned resources in your content area of expertise
- Add Washington learning standards alignment information to reviewed resources
- Recommend exemplar resources for OSPI content lead recognition based on expanded review criteria

Qualifications

- Washington PreK–12 educator, school district administrator, or Educational Service District staff
- Expertise in content area learning standards and teaching practices
- Preferred: Familiarity with the Washington OER Hub

Please note that submission of an application does not guarantee selection as a resource reviewer. Final decisions will be based on a combination of applicant qualifications, experience, and the need to ensure coverage across diverse content areas and grade bands.
