

Bridging the Digital Divide: Empowering Families, Building Community In Eastern Washington, the Warden School District used a Digital Navigation grant from OSPI to host sessions aimed at helping parents and caregivers become more comfortable with technology.





The district hosted six training sessions beginning in April 2024. District staff organized childcare and provided food during the sessions to make it easier for families to attend. All sessions were available in both English and Spanish.
