Purpose: In an effort to improve the current processing system for educator certification applications in Washington state, OSPI is working with PESB to implement a new application deadline system that requires renewal certification applications to be submitted six months in advance of the certification expiration date. To enforce this change, OSPI is adopting rulemaking to make effective starting in the 2030 renewal cycle a late fee for educators who submit applications after their respective certification application be added and a state.
