Background

The reporting requirement ([RCW 28A.655.075](#) and [RCW 28A.230.095](#)) for educational technology classroom-based assessments administered in the elementary, middle, and high school grades is no longer a separate survey out to districts. To meet the legislative requirement, district reporting on these assessments is now included in the annual OSPI Educational Technology Survey that is sent to district designated Technology Directors.
