All Washington State school districts are eligible. Grants are funded through the Washington State Legislature and administered by the Financial Education Public-Private Partnership



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THE GRANT

Form Package 672 Financial Education Professional Development

The goal of the grant is to support school districts increasing financial education and sustaining its impact. Grant activities may include integrating financial education into courses and classrooms; teacher professional development in financial education, and developing community engagement opportunities. Grant applications are available through EGMS. This will be the final year of this grant opportunity, as provided by SB 5720.

Financial education is vital for navigating today's complex economic landscape, and we have the opportunity to empower teachers' and students' futures.



Districts are eligible for \$7.50 per enrolled student. Professional development is required for educators impacted by district financial education goals. This can include professional development (including teacher compensation, travel, substitute coverage, and fees), instructional resources, supplies, and district indirect costs.
