1. Open [Washington State Report Card](#). Report Card is accessible on the OSPI website under "Data and Reporting".

OSPI collects extensive amounts of data that are used for school and district accountability; providing information to the Legislature and other stakeholders; and policymaking at the state, local, and federal levels. 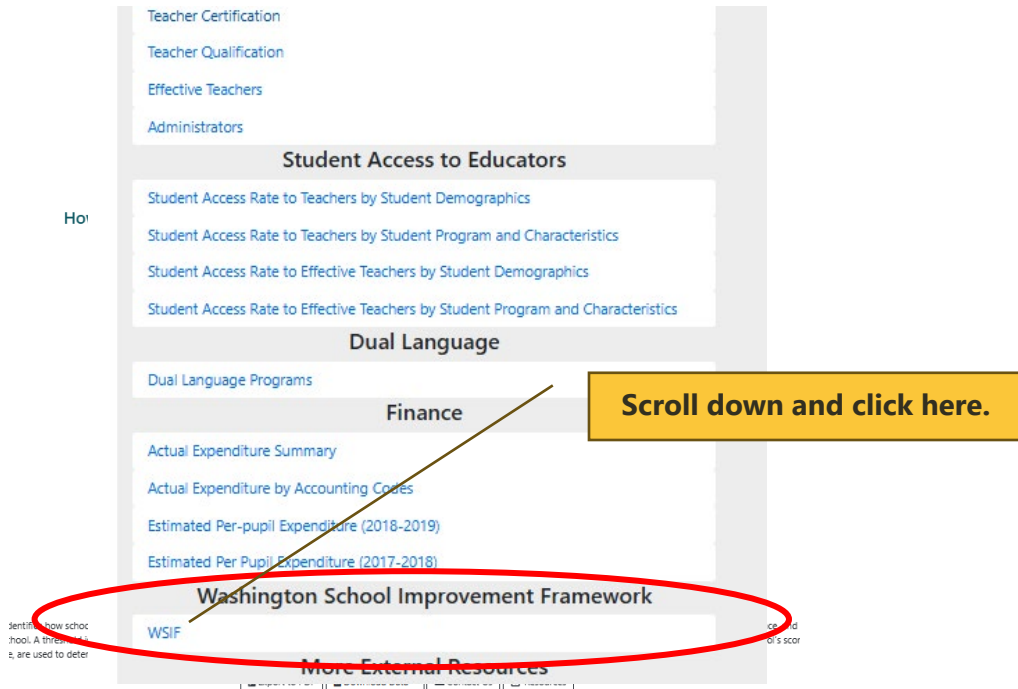
2. Once in Washington State Report Card, find the search box under "I want to see data for a school or school district" and enter school name.
 - a. A dropdown menu will appear and you can select your school and district.
 - b. Click on the green "Go" button.

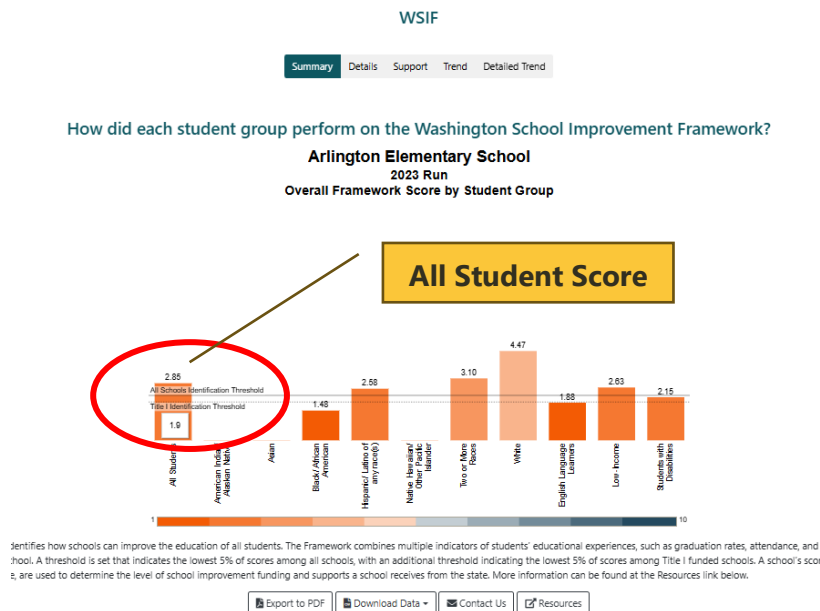

- Once your school's report card loads, scroll down and locate the "WSIF" section on the left-hand menu.



- The first section you should see is the "Summary" to see your school's 2023 WSIF Cycle Identification.
 - Cycle 3 ID thresholds:
 - All schools: 2.25
 - Title I: 1.90
 - ELP: 9.4
 - Graduation Rate: 66.7%



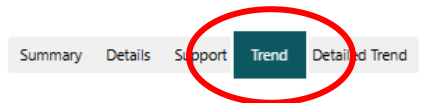
5. Click on "Support" to see your Cycle 3 Support Status.



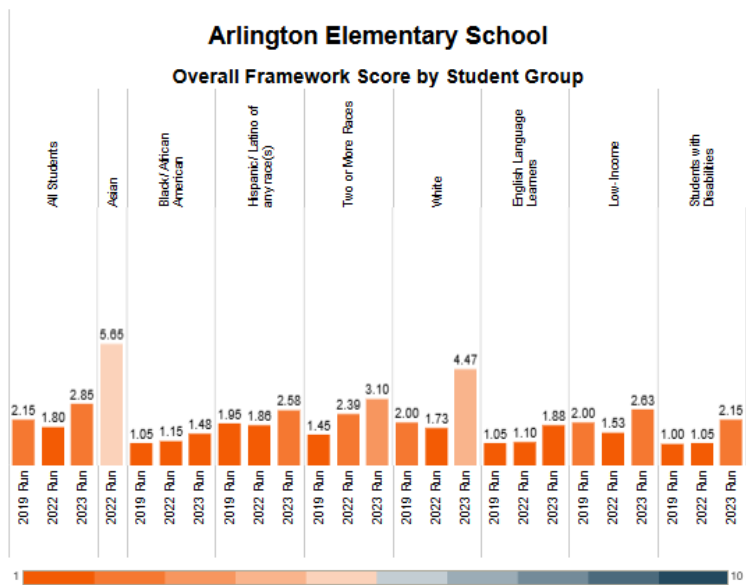
Which schools are receiving additional support based on the Washington School Improvement Framework?
