If ANY of the 2,000 hours is more than six years old, 300 hours of industry experience is required in the past two years.

The Business and Industry route program **will NOT gain** the CTE Agriculture V010000, CTE Business and Marketing Ed V078000, CTE Family and Consumer Science Ed V200002, or CTE Technology Ed V210100 endorsements.
