   Answer: You do not need to live in or have a business address in Washington in order to bid on this contract. However, you do need to be licensed to do business in the State of Washington. If you are not currently licensed, you will need to provide a written intent to become licensed in Washington within thirty (30) calendar days of being selected as the Apparently Successful Contractor.
- 2. Question: I am interested in applying to be a grant reviewer. Is there anywhere I can find additional information regarding the procedure to do so, application requirements, and application process overall? I appreciate any insight you may be able to provide.

- 3. **Question:** [In reference to the "Project Management/Team Structure/Internal Controls" section of the Management Proposal] Since it is only me as I am an independent reviewer, do I just submit a chart to you with my name on it and the amount of time I can dedicate to the review of each application?

**Answer:** Provide a description of the proposed project team structure and internal controls to be used during the course of the project, including any subcontractors. Identify staff, including subcontractors, who will be assigned to the potential contract, indicating the responsibilities and qualifications of such personnel, and include the amount of time each will be assigned to the project.



Provide an organizational chart of your firm indicating lines of authority for personnel involved in performance of this potential contract and relationships of this staff to other programs or functions of the firm. This chart must also show lines of authority to the next senior level of management. Include who within the firm will have prime responsibility and final authority for the work.
