Reason 1: WA0007 Elementary Course Code

- WA0007 is the elementary curriculum course code.
- It aligns to the elementary endorsement.

Problem: When WA0007 is used for specialists such as art, music and PE if the educator does not hold an elementary endorsement as these teachers are only in-field when teaching the subjects aligned to their endorsement. They are considered out-of-field for WA0007 since the all elementary content areas do not align to their endorsement.

Solution: Use the content-specific K-8 course codes.

Course Codes for Special Education

Special Education is a service, not a course, yet there are ways to code special education teachers that may be applicable in your LEA

Special Education Program Model	Course Code
Self-contained life skills	19257 Life Skills (do not use a "miscellaneous" course code)
Self-contained courses included in a student's IEP	Use the content course code of the subject area, e.g.,02062 Integrated Math I
Inclusion model where the special education teacher co-teaches in the general education classroom	 For each course: Enter "I" as the teacher indicator for the special education teacher. Enter "P" as the teacher indicator for the general education teacher.



Reason 3: S-275 Reporting Error

- The S-275 is a reporting process for certificated and classified personnel.
- An LEA will report each person's duty code such as teacher, school counselor, principal, paraeducator, etc.

Problem 1: A non-teacher, such as school counselors or principals, have a teacher duty code in the S-275.

Problem 2: A teacher is reported to the wrong school.

Solution: Correct the S-275 Report
