**Purpose:** In alignment with SSSB 5882 (2024), passed by the Washington State Legislature in 2024, OSPI is adopting rulemaking to establish requirements for school districts to utilize allocated funding for the 2024-2025 school year to support paraeducators, office support, and noninstructional aides. Additionally, consistent with legislative directive to collect data on the use of allocations, the rules would require local education agencies to provide reports that detail the uses of the allocations.
