Conditions & Duration of Classroom Exclusions	<p>(2) A teacher may exclude a student from the teacher's individual classroom and instructional or activity area while the student is under the teacher's immediate supervision, subject to the requirements in <a href="#">WAC 392-400-110</a>.</p> <p>(3) <b>Duration of classroom exclusion.</b></p> <p>(b) A classroom exclusion that exceeds this time period, and if such students have repeatedly disrupted the learning of other students, may be considered a suspension in accordance with this chapter and must provide for early involvement of parents in attempts to improve the student's behavior.</p> <p>(c) <b>Removal from school.</b> A student may not be removed from school during a classroom exclusion unless the school district provides notice and due process for a suspension, expulsion, or emergency removal under this chapter.</p>	<p>(2) <b>Conditions</b></p> <p>A teacher may exclude a student from the teacher's individual classroom and instructional or activity area while the student is under the teacher's immediate supervision, subject to the requirements in <a href="#">RCW 28A.600.460</a>.</p> <p>(3) <b>Duration</b></p> <p>(b) A classroom exclusion that exceeds this time period, and if such students have repeatedly disrupted the learning of other students, <b>consistent with</b> <a href="#">RCW 28A.600.460</a>, may be considered a suspension in accordance with this chapter and must provide for early involvement of parents in attempts to improve the student's behavior.</p> <p>(4) <b>Removal from school.</b> A student may not be removed from school during a classroom exclusion unless the school district provides notice and due process for a suspension, expulsion, or emergency removal under this chapter.</p>
