PURPOSE/BACKGROUND

The 2025 Washington State Legislative Session concluded on April 27, and the Legislature passed several new bills, budget provisos, and requirements for school districts. Part of the role of the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) is to support school districts in tracking and implementing new legislative requirements. As such, OSPI has compiled and published a <u>summary of new K-12 bills and budget items</u> that have been signed into law by Governor Bob Ferguson. OSPI has also compiled a <u>list of requirements for school districts</u> that are either new as a result of legislation passed this legislative session, or requirements from previous legislative sessions that are going into effect this school year or next.
