#### The Challenge


- Lack of confidence = stalled progress
- Doubt weakens vision and focus
- Meeting goals becomes difficult, sometimes impossible







### Knowing the Goals




- Beyond memorization
- Understand purpose and outcomes
- Connect roles to goals
- Use process mapping for alignment




## Believing in the Work

- "Seeing is believing"
- Break isolation between classrooms
- Share wins across teams and schools
- Belief grows when success is visible, share success stories





#### Receiving Relevant Feedback



- Feedback should be timely and clear
- Tie directly to school goals
- Avoid data overload focus on what matters
- Highlight gaps and progress



### The Cost of Not Implementing

- Small delays = big problems later
- Off by 1° at 100 yards= 5.24 feet
- Off by 1° at 1,000
  miles = 17.45 miles
- Early corrections are critical





#### Course Correction Strategy



- Plan checkpoints early
- Set dates for planning meetings
- Review data regularly
- Engage community in progress



#### Conclusion


- Confidence grows when teams:
