OSPI will provide feedback to Tier 3 and Tier 3 Plus schools on the mid-year review and end of year review. Work with schools on completing their needs assessments and school improvement plans. Outline how LEAs will support the development, 	 Online L-CAP completed and submitted by August 28, 2026. Applications for the 2026-27 1003 Improvement Grants must include a completed Alchemer L-CAP survey report (.pdf export) as part of the application process via EGMS.

 Step 6 (for school leaders): 2026-27 School Improvement Plan (SIP) Create your 2026-27 SIP by update or adjust the 2025-26 School Improvement Plan (SIP) and/or adding new goals based on the results of the Comprehensive Needs Assessment (CNA) review. Explicitly call out resource inequities and how they will be addressed in the 2026-27 SIP. Use Evidence-Based Interventions (EBIs) to support the implementation of the SIP. Pro Tip: Create the 2026-27 SIP and get School Board approval by the end of the 2025-26 school year.
