About the Community of Practice

Washington state is participating in a <u>national challenge</u> to reduce chronic absence by 50%. Starting January 2026, OSPI is hosting a Statewide Attendance Community of Practice (CoP) as part of Washington's effort to increase attendance. This CoP will bring together district leaders and their teams to share strategies, collaborate, and learn best practices for improving student attendance. Facilitators will provide guidance, resources, research, and lead discussions focused on the district's role in supporting schools to achieve better attendance outcomes.

Who Can Attend:

- Districts who have committed to <u>Washington's 5-year Challenge to Cut Chronic Absence</u> in Half.
- Recommended attendees: district lead, district attendance data specialist, and other district staff who are committed to working on attendance to support the whole child (e.g. Counseling, Health, and Safety)
- While we welcome school administrators as participants, this network will primarily focus on the district actions necessary to support attendance and engagement district-wide.
