## **Request for Proposal Released for SAFS Systems Replacement**

An RFP has been released for the development of a new data collection, calculation, and reporting system that will replace most, if not all, major SAFS systems. The system is going by the name of SASQUATCH (School Apportionment System for Quality, Accountability, and Transparency Calculation Hub). Proposals are due in early 2026 and we expect work to begin on development in mid- 2026 – with the first system changes released for the 2027-28 school year. Once a vendor is selected, we will be sending out more regular updates on the development and rollout plans with tentative timelines.

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### **Expenditure Data for State Report Card System**

OSPI and districts are required to report school level expenditure data on the state and district report card. This release of the state report card using school year 2024-25 actual financial data is scheduled to be on January 12, 2026.

Before the public release, districts have an opportunity to review the information through the EDS system logins. I am sending you this notice to ask that you notify and work with your districts to review their data during the review period. **This review window will open to school districts on December 29, 2025 and will close on January 9, 2026.**

As a reminder, all expenditures reported in a district level non-instructional location has been spread across the instructional locations based on district enrollment. Gideon will not be able to make any targeted changes to this formula by instructional location. This review is to check for data accuracy based on information as it was reported on the F-196 financial statements. 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## F-203 and F-200 Updates

On Friday, December 12, the F-203 revenue estimate system will move back into the X-option format. Districts will then have view only access to their original F-203 estimates. Since the system cannot copy estimates from the F-203 form to the F-203 X-option form, districts will have to reenter their F-203 estimate information if they wish to create a baseline from which to model.
