Student-Teacher Contact Requirements

Washington Virtual School (WAVS) students communicate with teachers via email, phone, IM, text, or attend a Live Lesson. Students are required to have two-way reciprocal communication each week with their teacher or engagement advisor, discussing academic progress.

Each student has a Written Student Learning Plan (WSLP), and a record of communication will be kept and data transmitted to the Office of Superintendent and Public Instruction (OSPI). Weekly contact between the student and certified teacher for instruction, review of assignments, testing, evaluation of student progress, or other learning activities or requirements identified in the WSLP. For the first month, a WAVS student must have evidence of participation on or before the count day. For the subsequent months, a WAVS student will have two-way weekly contact with a certified teacher related to the instructional goals outlined in the WSLP.

Stellar Virtual will create a digital report from the Washington Virtual Schools Student Information System (SIS) in the agreed-upon format to provide the partner district with this data. This report will include one-to-one contact with the teacher via email, phone, IM, video, and face-to-face contact.

Stellar Virtual and Washington Virtual Schools will work with the partner district to submit enrollment numbers during the school year and provide an end-of-year report to OSPI through School Apportionment and Financial Services (SAFS) in the Education Data System (EDS) by the end of August.
