Using the Disciplinary Removals Application

Introduction/Purpose

Federal and state special education regulations require that school districts provide information regarding the numbers and types of students with IEPs who were suspended/expelled during the school year. These reports cover the entire school year and include students aged 3 to 21, as of the federal child count date. All school districts are required to submit these data reports.

This application captures data used for federal IDEA reporting and disproportionality identification. It provides districts with a centralized tool to review and verify the accuracy and completeness of their data prior to submission. Because state and federal reporting requires disciplinary data for all students—not only those with IEPs—the application includes all removals for students enrolled in the district.

The data is pre-populated from the Comprehensive Education Data and Research System (CEDARS). Details regarding which data are being pre-populated is described in the appropriate sections within this User Guide. All updates to this data must be made through a re-submission of data to CEDARS.

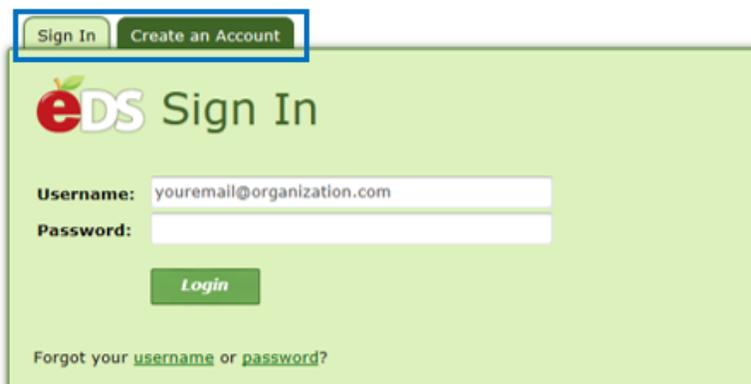
CEDARS refreshes the data in the report nightly until the application closes on September 15, 2026 or until the report is submitted by a district user.

Accessing the Application

To access the Disciplinary Removals Application:

- [Log into the Education Data System \(EDS\)](#).
- Select 'I Agree' on the Acceptable Use window.
- Select 'View My Applications'
- Select the 'Special Education Reporting' link.

If you do not have an EDS account, create one by clicking on the Create an Account tab at the EDS sign-in screen or by contacting your District Security Manager (DDSM). If you have an EDS login, but do not see the Behavior and Weapons application in your list, contact your DDSM. [A list of district security managers can be found in EDS](#).



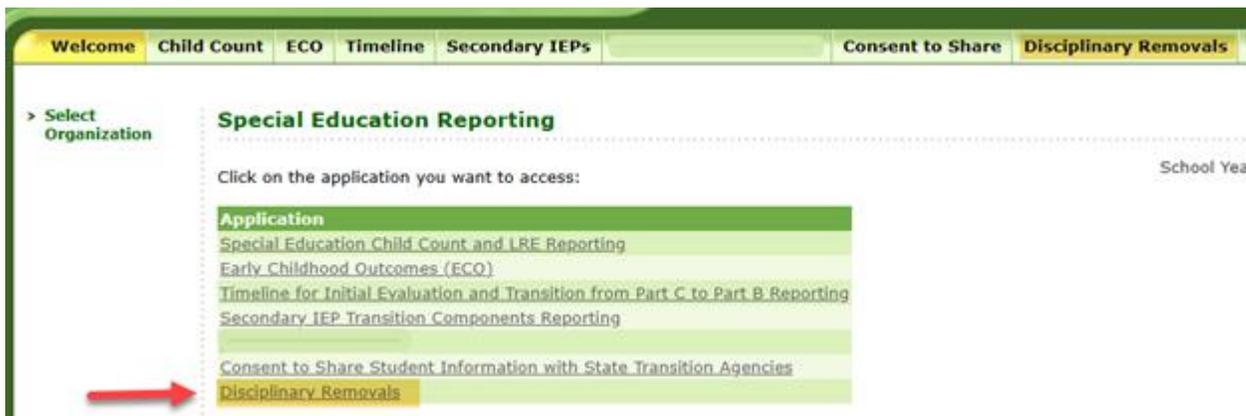

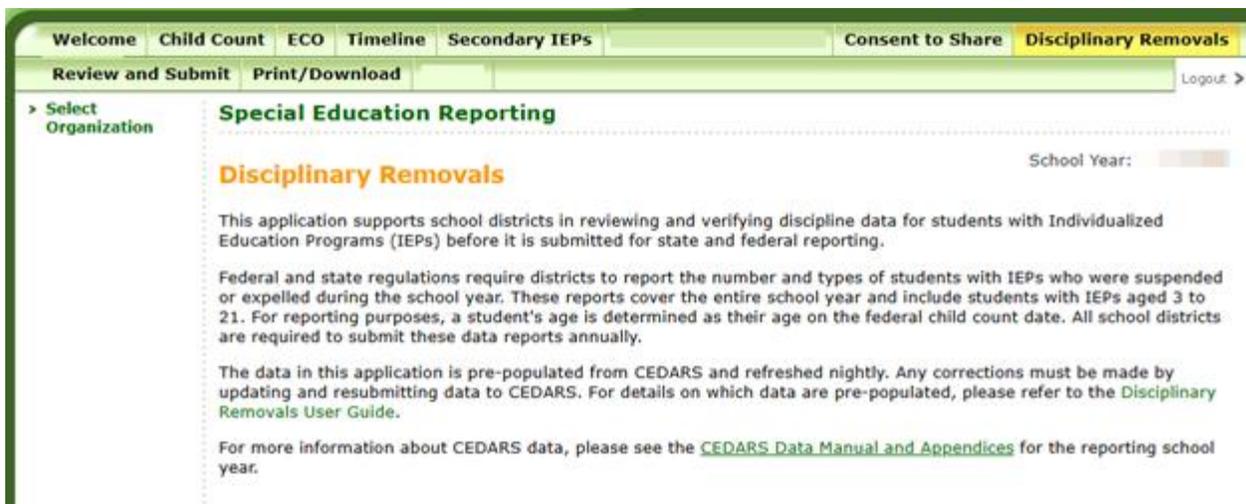
Please work with your CEDARS District Administrator to analyze and plan any corrections to student data.

The welcome screen below is the first screen you will see after logging into Special Education Reporting.

Select the *Disciplinary Removals* application.

Required Activities in this Application

Review and Submit Tab

To complete the required activity, verify that the information in the table is accurate and reflects all disciplinary removals for the reporting year for students with and without IEPs. The reporting period is July 1 through June 30 annually and the data in the application is pre-populated using your school district's CEDARS data submissions. The discipline data comes from the CEDARS Student Exclusionary Discipline File (R) and additional student demographic information is included from files B, I, J, and K. For more detailed information, refer to the [CEDARS Data Manual](#) and [Appendices](#).

If an error is discovered, LEAs will need to resubmit corrected data through a CEDARS submission. Data will be refreshed nightly until the system closes on September 15, 2026 or until the report is submitted by a district user.

Please Note: Although the application will be open to review records throughout the year, the *Submit* button will not be available until July 1, 2026 — after the close of the reporting period.

Once this data has been reviewed and confirmed to be accurate and complete, click the "Submit" button to notify OSPI staff. Both OSPI staff and the submitter will receive an email confirming submission. If changes need to be made, refer to the section titled *Revising the Application*. This must be completed no later than September 15, 2026.

If your LEA has no records to submit, then click the "Submit" button confirming no students to report.

Revising the Submission

There will be instances in which the User will need to revise a record after the application has been submitted. To do this, log in to the application and navigate to the *Review and Submit* tab. Click on the link requesting an unlock (see screenshot below).

Clicking the link will generate an email to OSPI Special Education staff who will then unlock the LEAs data as requested. The person requesting the unlock will receive an email when the application has been unlocked.

Once the application is unlocked, any updated CEDARS data will flow into the application within 24 hours. The application must be resubmitted after the revisions are complete.

The Review and Submit subtab generates the list of disciplinary removals of all students age 3 to 21.

The reporting cycle for this data collection is July 1 through June 30 annually, utilizing the LEAs CEDARS Submissions of File R and other demographic data available through CEDARS.

Once this data has been reviewed and confirmed to be accurate and complete, click the "Submit" button to finalize and lock the records. This action must be completed no later than October 1, 2026. After submission, any subsequent updates made in CEDARS will not be reflected in this report. If an error is discovered, districts must resubmit corrected data through a CEDARS submission. The finalized data will be used for federal IDEA reporting and the identification of disproportionality.
