School districts are required to provide to the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) a brief summary of their policies, procedures, programs, partnerships, vendors, and instructional and training materials prohibiting harassment, intimidation, and bullying (HIB).

How the Data are Used

These data are posted on OSPI's school safety center website, as required by the RCW. These data are also used by OSPI's school safety team to provide program support.

Instructions

Action Required

District HIB Compliance Officers are required to annually verify the [posted information](#), and to notify OSPI of any updates or changes. On March 2, 2026, OSPI emailed district HIB Compliance Officers the instructions to review the posted information, and a link to a form to make necessary updates.
