Overview

Bellevue Digital Discovery offers K–12 flexible learning options for students and families. Our elementary model follows Alternative Learning Experience (ALE) model. Students and families have three options:

- **Online Learning:** Students have Bellevue School District (BSD) homeroom teachers and BSD elementary specialists. This model has 70% of the school time is synchronous online instruction with real-time instruction between students and their BSD teachers. Students have one flex day where they can choose to be online or go to our site-based workshops.
- **Remote Learning:** Students have BSD homeroom teachers and BSD elementary specialists. In this model, students can attend up to two days a week of site-based workshops led by BSD teachers, have a BSD mentor teacher to support students and families. Families utilize district curriculum to have students learn remotely at home with their family.

Our secondary model also follows the ALE model. Our secondary program includes a partnership with Imagine Edgenuity and allows significant flexibility in where and when students engage in their learning. Students also attend Academic Seminar with two synchronous lessons taught by BSD mentor teachers per week and, for students not yet meeting standards in their online classes, a third day of meeting to receive additional support. The BSD mentor teacher checks in with students, answers any questions and the curriculum, and evaluates their progress.

Student-Teacher Contact Requirements

Online elementary students are expected to attend all daily scheduled class meetings, including approximately 20 hours of scheduled synchronous learning (70% of their total instructional time of 28 hours) weekly.

Remote elementary students are expected to attend all site-based classes and participate in their remote learning experience which would be 28 hours, per week.

Secondary students are required to attend their academic seminar class 2 times weekly during scheduled synchronous class meetings. In addition, secondary students are required to complete their asynchronous coursework in Imagine Edgenuity for a total instructional time for a total of 27.75 hours of instructional time weekly for full-time students. The school may take a variety of actions to help improve a student's attendance and timeliness.
