## **2026-27 F-203 SAFS Revenue Estimating System Coming Soon | Action Needed**

We are in the final stages of preparing our F-203 budget system for the 2026-27 school year. In order to transition the system from the 2025-26 school year to the 2026-27 school year, we will need to take the system offline.

**This message is to serve as your warning and notification that the system will be taken down at the end of the workday on March 26 and all work currently contained in the F-203 will not be retrievable after the system gets released for the 2026-27 school year. Please print and retain all critical F-203 work outside of the system prior 4 pm on March 26.**

The system will be offline for a minimum of two business days so that we can load the 2026-27 F-203. We are anticipating the release of the F-203 no later than Tuesday, March 31.
