Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish: OSPI is considering rulemaking to update language in existing WACs to include removing reference to outdated terms, staff mix, updating terms such as ABFR Guidance (not handbook), educational programs and operation (not excess maintenance and operation) levy, and students with disability (not handicapped and nonhandicapped students), and aligning rules with existing statute.


