

Comprehensive Sexual Health Education Data Collection

Action Required for Data Collection

In accordance with [Revised Code of Washington 28A.300.475](#), all schools are required to report to OSPI on their implementation of Comprehensive Sexual Health Education (CSHE). This is due by **September 1, 2026**. Submitting this once per district meets the statutory requirements. Districts should ensure the submission is completed by an individual with districtwide knowledge of CSHE programming.

Instructions

To meet this requirement, school districts and LEAs can complete a [district-level reporting tool](#) before the end of the 2025–26 school year. Please submit one survey response per district/LEA. OSPI recommends that each district/LEA designate a lead health teacher or curriculum director (or someone familiar with the instruction provided) to report for the district.

Key Dates

- **Collection opens:** May 1, 2026
- **Submission deadline:** September 1, 2026

Additional Information

- All schools are required to provide comprehensive sexual health education (CSHE) to all students in multiple grades and report to OSPI by September 1 of each year on their implementation of CSHE in accordance with [Revised Code of Washington 28A.300.475](#).

How OSPI Uses the Data

OSPI summarizes the results and reports this to the legislature biennially. Results of this collection also help OSPI understand CSHE implementation across the state to tailor resources, professional development, and technical assistance to schools.
