Students in the Bellevue School District represent a richly diverse community, with families originating from approximately 125 countries and speaking more than 115 languages at home. Over the past decade, Nutrition Services has celebrated this diversity by expanding menu offerings and intentionally marketing culturally inclusive entrées. Many of these dishes also highlight locally sourced ingredients.

This year's menu features scratch-made options such as Butter Chicken or Chickpeas, Braised Beef Birria Tacos made with local beef, a Salmon Bowl with Edamame prepared with local salmon, and Pork Pozole Verde made with local pork.

Nutrition Services also introduced the new pozole recipe at a tasting event with parents at Bellevue High School, creating an opportunity for family engagement and feedback.
