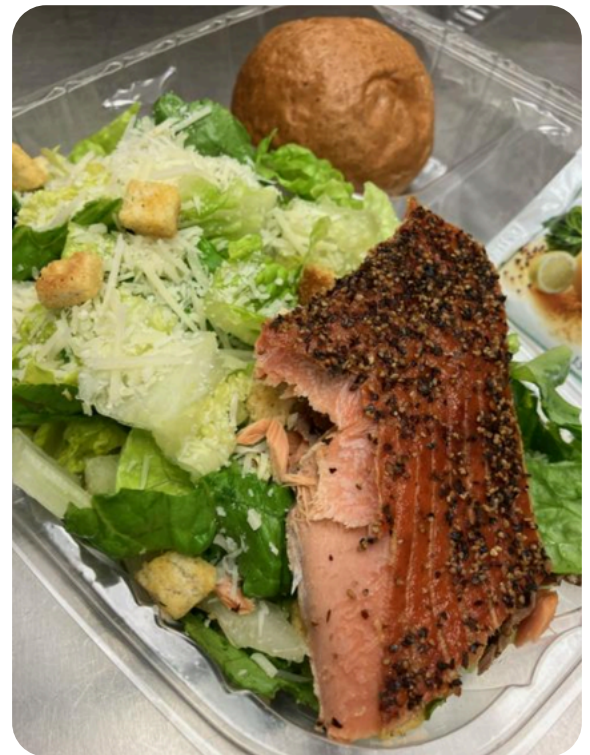
Highline Public Schools

Culinary students ensured that each recipe meets minimum creditable meal component requirements and aligns with weekly meal pattern guidelines.

The district also used a Farm to School grant to bring locally sourced menu items to life, including a Smoked Salmon Caesar Salad made with Washington-grown salmon.
