Purpose of the District Planning Template

To strengthen alignment across a district, OSPI recommends districts put a plan in place for how administrators will access the Government-to-Government Relationships training. This will help ensure administrators across the district have clear and consistent information aligned with existing district partnerships and meaningful consultation practices. This template, filled out at the superintendent's office, may be used for district planning purposes, and then distributed to district administrative staff.
