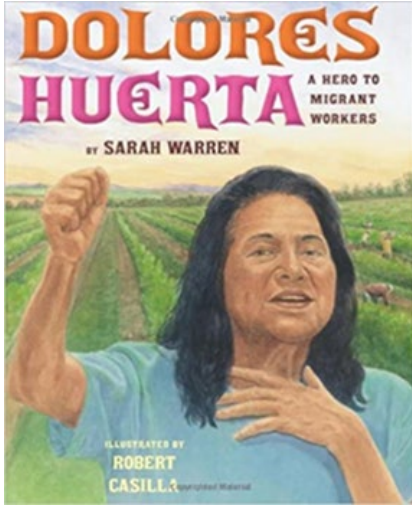


Dolores Huerta:
