

#### Standard: Saving 4-1

#### **Financial Education and Economic Vocabulary**

<u>budget</u> A plan for spending money

<u>choice</u> A decision made between two or more alternatives

opportunity cost What is given up when a choice is made; the second choice

<u>saving</u> (verb) Setting money aside for future spending

<u>savings</u> (noun) Money set aside for future spending

<u>savings goal</u> A plan to save money for a specific future purchase
