Subsidize Class and Exam Fees

- 1. Purpose: Funding was provided to subsidize advance placement exam fees for low income students. To be eligible for the subsidy, students must have been eligible to participate in the federal free or reduced price lunch program, and the student must have maximized the allowable federal contribution.
- **2. Description of services provided**: School districts with the International Baccalaureate Program paid registration fees for low-income students taking International Baccalaureate exams and were reimbursed by OSPI through iGrants.
- **3. Criteria for grants:** Eligible recipients were schools with low-income students who took International Baccalaureate exams in 2017.
- **4. Beneficiaries in State FY 2016-17 School Year:** 17 schools in 15 districts.
