Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish: OSPI is considering rulemaking concerning elective high school credit for work experience. The rules may clarify implementation requirements for schools and ensure students have access to elective credit. The proposed rule making does not seek to impact or modify laws or rules related to employing youth.
